NZ Funds KiwiSaver Scheme Growth Strategy

What is the purpose of this statement?

This statement provides key information about the NZ Funds KiwiSaver Scheme Growth Strategy. It tells you how the fund has performed and what fees it charged, and will help you to compare it with other funds. We prepared this statement in accordance with the KiwiSaver (Periodic Disclosure) Regulations 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of the fund

The objective of the Growth Strategy is to grow your investment over the long-term by investing in income-oriented assets and growth-oriented assets using an active investment management approach.

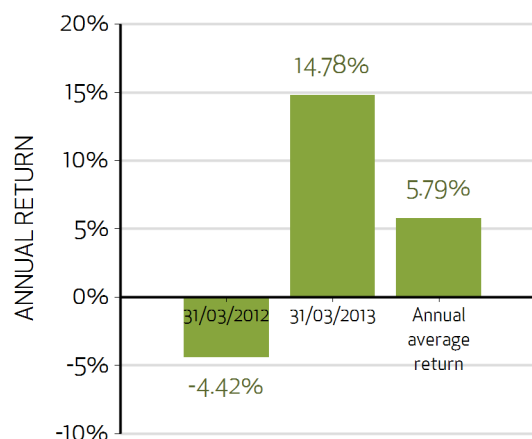

What fees were members charged?

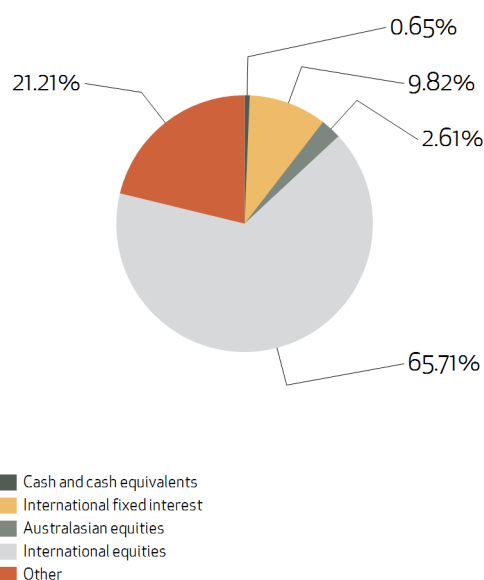
Example of how this applies to a member

Emma had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and didn't make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Emma received a return after fund fees and tax were deducted of \$1,817.00 (that's 18.17% of her initial \$10,000). Emma also paid \$42.30 in membership fees. This gives Emma a total return of \$1,774.70 for the year.

Notes

- ¹ Returns in this statement are after tax at the highest prescribed investor rate (PIR) of tax for an individual New Zealand resident. Your tax rate may be lower.
- ² Fund fees are fees charged as a percentage of a member's interest in the fund (i.e. as a percentage of their KiwiSaver account balance).
- ³ Other fees and costs comprise:
 - (a) operating costs directly incurred by the fund; and
 - (b) annual management fees, performance-based fees and operating costs incurred by underlying funds the fund invests into.

Included within other fees and costs are performance-based fees, which totalled 0.63% per annum, that were charged by the underlying external funds the fund invests into. Performance-based fees are subject to market movements and external manager performance. The amount of these performance-based fees for the current period may materially differ from the performance-based fees being disclosed for the year to 31 March 2013.

Estimates were used when deriving annual management fees, performance-based fees and operating costs incurred by certain underlying funds that the fund invests into. A list of underlying funds where estimates were used follows.

Magellan Global Fund	<p>The performance-based fee is confirmed biannually each June and December by the administrator of the Magellan Global Fund. Outside of these dates, an estimate of this fee is calculated using the same performance criteria as that used by the administrator of the Magellan Global Fund.</p> <p>Fee and operating cost information obtained from the administrator of the Magellan Global Fund was for the year to 31 December 2012.</p>
The Eclectica Fund	<p>The performance-based fee is confirmed annually each December by the administrator of the Eclectica Fund. Outside of this date, an estimate of this fee is calculated using the same performance criteria as that used by the administrator of the Eclectica Fund.</p> <p>The fee and operating cost amount for the Eclectica Fund was estimated by using the rate disclosed in their prospectus plus a 0.12% allowance for administration, legal, audit and director costs.</p>
Nuveen Mortgage Opportunity Term Fund	<p>Fee and operating cost information obtained from the administrator of the Nuveen Mortgage Opportunity Term Fund was for the year to December 2012 and six months to June 2013. A date-apportioned approach was used to calculate the fee and operating costs.</p>
Nuveen Mortgage Opportunity Term Fund Two	<p>Fee and operating cost information obtained from the administrator of the Nuveen Mortgage Opportunity Term Fund Two was for the year to December 2012 and six months to June 2013. A date-apportioned approach was used to calculate the fee and operating costs.</p>

- ⁴ Membership fees are the fixed dollar charges for membership in the KiwiSaver scheme. For members who invested in more than one fund in the NZ Funds KiwiSaver Scheme, \$42.30 was the maximum membership fees charged over the year to 31 March 2013. From 1 September 2013, membership fees have increased to \$42.72 per annum, in line with the New Zealand Consumer Price index.
- ⁵ NZ Funds uses derivatives as part of its active investment management approach. The use of derivatives can result in the fund being leveraged. Leverage occurs when the total economic exposure exceeds 100%. Where leverage exists the actual investment mix pie chart and the target investment mix table have been scaled to total 100%. Removing the effect of scaling, the total economic exposure of the fund as shown in the actual investment mix and the target investment mix, would be 153.87% and 153.00% respectively. - NZ Funds uses an active investment management approach and as a result the target investment mix may change from time to time.
- ⁶ The top 10 investments have been compiled using a balance sheet approach. This differs from the approach used in compiling the actual and target investment mixes, which include the impact of derivatives.

Revised Disclosure Statement

As a result of discussions with external advisors, we have further considered the disclosures of certain items in the 30 September 2013 quarterly disclosure statement filed on 21 October 2013. The changes made to the original 30 September 2013 quarterly disclosure statement are summarised below:

- When compiling the actual investment mix and related footnotes, we have moved from using a balance sheet approach to a scaled economic exposure approach.
- When compiling the target investment mix and related footnotes, we have moved from using a balance sheet approach to a scaled economic exposure approach.
- In the top 10 investments table, credit ratings have now been provided for deposit and margin accounts.
